**THE HERTFORDSHIRE (TEMPORARY CLOSING OF THE STREET, FURNEUX  
PELHAM/LITTLE HORMEAD) ORDER 2017**

NOTICE is given that the Hertfordshire County Council intends to make an Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, to prohibit all traffic from using that length of The Street, Furneux Pelham/Little Hormead from its junction with East End north westwards, south westwards and north westwards to its junction with Worsted Lane ("the Road"), a distance of approximately 5601 metres, except for access.

An alternative route will be via C107 (unnamed road), C35 (unnamed road), Patient End, Braughing Road, Pelham Road, The Street, Ford Street, B1368 (Green End/Hay Street/Dassels/Dassels Hill/unnamed road) and Worsted Lane.

The Order is needed because utility service installation works are proposed to be executed on or near the Road.

If the Order is made, it shall come into force on 13 February 2017 for a period of up to 18 months. However, the restrictions specified shall only take effect at the times indicated by signs on or near the Road.

A copy of the proposed Order may be inspected free of charge at County Hall, Hertford between the hours of 9.00am and 5.00pm (excluding weekends, bank and public holidays).
