### THE HERTFORDSHIRE (TEMPORARY CLOSING AND TEMPORARY WAITING RESTRICTIONS IN VARIOUS ROADS IN BUNTINGFORD, HARE STREET, DANE END, WHEMPSTEAD, GREAT HORMEAD, BRENT PELHAM, BENGEO, PUCKERIDGE, WARE AND GREAT AMWELL) ORDER 2018

NOTICE is given that the Hertfordshire County Council intends to make an Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, to prohibit all traffic from using the following lengths of roads ("the Roads") and to prohibit all vehicles from waiting at any time on both sides of these lengths of Roads whilst works are in progress:-

1. that length of Dixon Place, Buntingford from its junction with Bowling Green Lane north eastwards, south eastwards and north eastwards for its entire length.

There is no alternative route available for vehicles when the works are being carried out. However vehicular access to properties in this road will be maintained whenever possible throughout the duration of the works.

- 2. that length of B1038 Hare Street Road, Buntingford/B1368 (unnamed road), Hare Street from its junction with Station Road north eastwards to its junction with B1368 (unnamed road), a distance of approximately 2873 metres.**

**An alternative route will be via Station Road, London Road, A10 (unnamed road) and B1368 (Buntingford Road/Wickham Hill/Station Road/Green Street/Hay Street/ Dassels/ Dassels Hill/unnamed road).**

3. that length of The Pyghtle, Buntingford from its junction with B1038 Baldock Road northwards and north westwards for its entire length.

There is no alternative route available for vehicles when the works are being carried out. However vehicular access to properties in this road will be maintained whenever possible throughout the duration of the works.

4. that length of Whempstead Lane, Dane End from a point 937 metres north east of its junction with Mill Lane north eastwards for a distance of approximately 100 metres.

An alternative route will be via Whempstead Lane, Mill Lane, A602 (Watton at Stone Bypass/Ware Road/Tonwell Bypass), Sacombe Pound, Munden Road and Whempstead Lane.

5. that length of Whempstead Road, Whempstead from a point 350 metres south east of its junction with Mill Lane south eastwards for a distance of approximately 100 metres.

An alternative route will be via Whempstead Road, Town Lane, Church Green, Walkern Road, High Street, A602 (Watton at Stone Bypass/Ware Road) and Whempstead Road.

- 6. that length of B1038 (unnamed road), Great Hormead/B1038 Conduit Lane, Brent Pelham from its junction with B1368 (unnamed road) north eastwards to its junction with B1038 Pump Hill, a distance of approximately 4664 metres.**

**An alternative route will be via B1368 (unnamed road/Biggin Hill/London Road/High Street/ Cambridge Road/London Road), Church End, B1039 (Chishill Road/Barley Road/ Hall Lane/Great Chishill/unnamed road/Clanver End/Royston Road), A11 Royston Road, B1039 (Royston Road/Station Road), B1383 (Mutlow Hill/London Road/Cambridge Road/ High Street) and B1038 (Wicken Road/unnamed road/Hill Green/Clatterbury Lane/High Street/Pelham Road/unnamed road/Pump Hill).**

7. that length of Lodge Close, Bengoe from its junction with The Drive north westwards, north eastwards and south eastwards for its entire length.

There is no alternative route available for vehicles when the works are being carried out. However vehicular access to properties in this road will be maintained whenever possible throughout the duration of the works.

8. that length of Old Standon Hill, Puckeridge from its junction with Cambridge Road south eastwards for its entire length.

There is no alternative route available for vehicles when the works are being carried out. However vehicular access to properties in this road will be maintained whenever possible throughout the duration of the works.

9. the road leading to Nos.75-95 Vicarage Road, Ware from its junction with Vicarage Road north eastwards for its entire length.

There is no alternative route available for vehicles when the works are being carried out. However vehicular access to properties in this road will be maintained whenever possible throughout the duration of the works.

10. that length of Presdales Drive, Ware from its junction with Hoe Lane south eastwards, south westwards and south eastwards to its junction with Post Wood Road, a distance of approximately 500 metres.

An alternative route will be via Hoe Lane, A119 London Road, A1170 London Road and Post Wood Road.

11. that length of Furlong Way, Great Amwell from its junction with Lower Road north eastwards and clockwise for its entire length.

There is no alternative route available for vehicles when the works are being carried out. However vehicular access to properties in this road will be maintained whenever possible throughout the duration of the works.

12. that length of Bridle Way, Great Amwell from its junction with Furlong Way south eastwards, north eastwards and north westwards for its entire length.

There is no alternative route available for vehicles when the works are being carried out. However vehicular access to properties in this road will be maintained whenever possible throughout the duration of the works.

13. that length of Blacksmiths Close, Great Amwell from its junction with Furlong Way north eastwards and north westwards for a distance of approximately 79 metres.

There is no alternative route available for vehicles when the works are being carried out. However vehicular access to properties in this road will be maintained whenever possible throughout the duration of the works.

The Order is needed because works are proposed to be executed on or near the Roads.

If the Order is made, it shall come into force on 9 April 2018 for a period of up to 18 months. However, the restrictions specified shall only take effect at the times indicated by signs on or near the Roads.

A copy of the proposed Order may be inspected free of charge at County Hall, Hertford between the hours of 9.00am and 5.00pm (excluding weekends, bank and public holidays).
