**THE HERTFORDSHIRE (TEMPORARY CLOSING OF THE STREET, LITTLE
HORMEAD/FURNEUX PELHAM) ORDER 2018**

NOTICE is given that the Hertfordshire County Council intends to make an Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, to prohibit all traffic from using that length of The Street, Little Hormead/Furneux Pelham from its junction with Worsted Lane south eastwards to its junction with The Causeway ("the Road"), a distance of approximately 4051 metres, except for access.

An alternative route will be via Worsted Lane, B1368 (unnamed road/Dassels Hill/Dassels/Hay Street/Green End), Ford Street, The Street, Pelham Road, Braughing Road, Patient End and The Causeway.

The Order is needed because utility service works are proposed to be executed on or near the Road.

If the Order is made, it shall come into force on 17 December 2018 for a period of up to 18 months. However, the restrictions specified shall only take effect at the times indicated by signs on or near the Road.

A copy of the proposed Order may be inspected free of charge at County Hall, Hertford between the hours of 9.00am and 5.00pm (excluding weekends, bank and public holidays).
