THE HERTFORDSHIRE (TEMPORARY CLOSING OF B1038 CONDUIT LANE, GREAT HORMEAD) ORDER 2019

NOTICE is given that the Hertfordshire County Council intends to make an Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, to prohibit all traffic from using that length of B1038 Conduit Lane, Great Hormead from its junction with Hall Lane south westwards to its junction with Andersons Lane ("the Road"), a distance of approximately 316 metres, except for access.

An alternative route will be via B1038 (Conduit Lane/Pump Hill/unnamed road/Pelham Road/High Street/Clatterbury Lane/Hill Green/unnamed road/Wicken Road), B1383 (High Street/Cambridge Road/London Road/Mutlow Hill), B1039 (Station Road/Royston Road/Clanver End/unnamed road/Great Chishill/Hall Lane/Barley Road/Chishill Road), Church End, B1368 (London Road/Cambridge Road/High Street/London Road/Biggin Hill/unnamed road) and B1038 (unnamed road).

The Order is needed because water leak repair works are proposed to be executed on or near the Road.

If the Order is made, it shall come into force on 10 April 2019 for a period of up to 18 months. However, the restrictions specified shall only take effect at the times indicated by signs on or near the Road.

A copy of the proposed Order may be inspected free of charge at County Hall, Hertford between the hours of 9.00am and 5.00pm (excluding weekends, bank and public holidays).
