THE HERTFORDSHIRE (TEMPORARY CLOSING OF HORSESHOE LANE, GREAT HORMEAD) ORDER 2019

NOTICE is given that the Hertfordshire County Council intends to make an Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, to prohibit all traffic from using that length of Horseshoe Lane, Great Hormead from a point 50 metres south west of its junction with Willow Close south westwards for a distance of approximately 80 metres ("the Road"), except for access.

An alternative route will be via Horseshoe Lane, Horseshoe Hill, B1038 (unnamed road), B1368 (unnamed road), Worsted Lane and Horseshoe Lane.

The Order is needed because electrical works are proposed to be executed on or near the Road.

If the Order is made, it shall come into force on 10 June 2019 for a period of up to 18 months. However, the restrictions specified shall only take effect at the times indicated by signs on or near the Road.

A copy of the proposed Order may be inspected free of charge at County Hall, Hertford between the hours of 9.00am and 5.00pm (excluding weekends, bank and public holidays).
