THE HERTFORDSHIRE (TEMPORARY CLOSING OF WORSTED LANE, LITTLE HORMEAD) ORDER 2019

NOTICE is given that the Hertfordshire County Council intends to make an Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, to prohibit all traffic from using that length of Worsted Lane, Little Hormead from its junction with B1368 (unnamed road) north eastwards to its junction with The Street ("the Road"), a distance of approximately 810 metres.

An alternative route will be via B1368 (unnamed road/Dassels Hill/Dassels/Hay Street/Green End), Ford Street, The Street, Pelham Road, Braughing Road, Patient End, The Causeway and The Street.

The Order is needed because utility maintenance works are proposed to be executed on or near the Road.

If the Order is made, it shall come into force on 7 March 2019 for a period of up to 18 months. However, the restrictions specified shall only take effect at the times indicated by signs on or near the Road.

A copy of the proposed Order may be inspected free of charge at County Hall, Hertford between the hours of 9.00am and 5.00pm (excluding weekends, bank and public holidays).
