RE: WW1 BEACONS OF LIGHT

I am delighted you are taking part in this unique, historic event by lighting a WW1 Beacon of Light in tribute to the millions of men and women who died or were injured in World War One.

Thank you for your most generous support in joining over 1,200 other organisations and local communities in lighting a beacon at 7pm on 11th November 2018 to commemorate the centenary of the end of the Great War.

Please note the following:

1) The current Guide to Taking Part in Battle's Over - A Nation's Tribute 11th November 2018 - the overarching event for this anniversary - will be updated again on 25th October 2018 to ensure that all those involved are listed in the publication. The guide can be viewed and downloaded at www.brunopeek.co.uk. You may also download the Battle's Over logo, which you are welcome to use in any printed or digital material you produce.

2) Please download the Tribute to the Millions from the website. This should be read out at 6.50pm to all those attending the lighting of your beacon by a local individual - a young person, veteran or dignitary. You could later frame and keep the tribute as a permanent reminder of your involvement.

3) If you have a bugler or trumpeter playing the Last Post, please ask them to undertake this at 6.55pm.

4) You should then light your beacon at 7pm.

5) You can now go to www.brunopeek.co.uk and download, print and frame a special certificate as a permanent reminder of your participation in this event.

6) Please ensure you have followed all the advice on page 21 of the Guide to Taking Part to ensure that you have a safe and successful event. This is your responsibility.

7) On the 1st November 2018 you will find on our website a press release template which you can download and tailor with details of your event, including the location, your name and contact details. You should send this direct to your local, regional and national media on 2nd November to generate publicity for your organisation.
